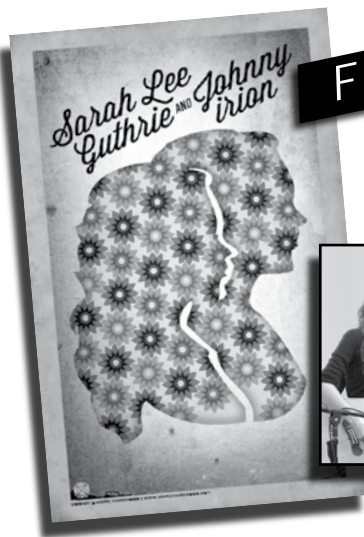

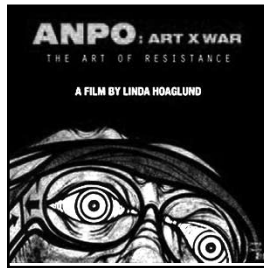

AsiaLENS Film Series presents ANPO: Art X War

Signed in 1960 amidst public resentment that erupted in massive popular demonstrations, ANPO refers to the United States-Japan Mutual Security Treaty, which permits the continued presence of numerous U.S. military bases in Japan. *ANPO: Art X War* reveals the story of resistance to the U.S. military bases through the lens of Japanese artists, by way of interviews and a collage of their extraordinary large scale paintings, drawings, photographs, anime, and films—some of which have long been hidden from public view.

AsiaLENS is a series of free public film screenings and lecture / discussion programs on issues reflecting contemporary life in Asia. The series is organized by the Asian Educational Media Service, a program of the Center for East Asian and Pacific Studies at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign.

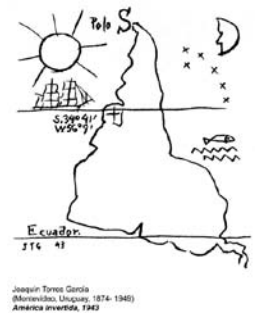
Busey-Mills Reading Room

Boneyard Artists

April 7 - 30 • Photography Exhibit by Philip Hartigan: In Urbana, I...

For the last nine months, Philip Hartigan has walked the streets of Urbana, asking people to finish the phrase "In Urbana, I..." People of all ages and backgrounds stepped up to write their response on a whiteboard and have their photo captured. Hartigan's project received an Envision 365 grant through the City of Urbana's Public Arts Commission, and was supported by the Market at the Square, Common Ground Food Co-op, Shared Space: An Artist Co-op, and The Urbana Free Library.

Originally from China, Hua Nian received a master's degree in Art Education from Pittsburg State University (Kansas), and is now an active exhibiting artist and instructor of Hua Nian Art Studio in Urbana. As well as being an acclaimed artist, Nian also offers art lessons for children in her studio, and on occasion, at the library. You can view the creative art work by the students of Hua Nian while they are on display at the library during the Boneyard Arts Festival.

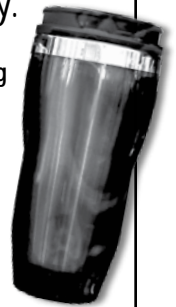

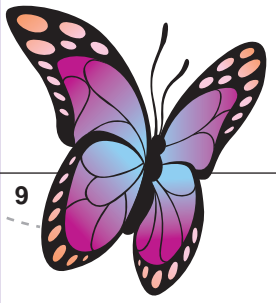
