Solar System 101 with Cosmologist Joaquin Vieira

In anticipation of the solar eclipse on August 21, we're exploring the skies. At this event, cosmologist **Joaquin Vieira** takes us on a tour of our solar system. Explore the planets, moons, and our sun, and learn some surprising facts about how our solar system works.

University of Illinois Professor Vieira is an observational cosmologist and an Assistant Professor at the **University of Illinois in the departments of Astronomy and Physics**. In an interview with the News-Gazette, Vieira said that cosmologists "observe how the universe began, what it is made of, how it evolves and try to determine its eventual fate. Specifically, I build telescopes and cameras to make pictures of the Big Bang and also to study distant galaxies."
