John Heider, a professional gravestone conservator, will teach and guide individuals on how to properly care for Illinois cemeteries and their historic grave markers. You will gain valuable knowledge on documenting a cemetery, safe cleaning practices, probing for unmarked graves, and repairing and resetting certain types of grave markers.

This is a two-part workshop. Part one is required and will take place Saturday, June 23, from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. in the Lewis Auditorium at The Urbana Free Library. **Part two** is cemetery field work and participants will sign up for either Saturday, June 23, from 1:00 to 4:00 p.m., or Sunday, June 24, from 1:00 to 4:00 p.m. at Roselawn Cemetery.
