The Velda Routh Collection was donated to the Champaign County Historical Archives by John T. Routh, son of Velda Routh, in December 2014.

Biographical Note:

Velda Routh was born July 18, 1918, in Athens, Illinois, to John Budd and Pearl Van Landingham. In 1941, she petitioned to have her last name changed to that of her adoptive parents, Colwell. She married Clifford Routh in 1942. Velda Routh passed away on June 17, 2011.

These records were created by Velda Routh to trace her family genealogy in hopes of documenting a connection to a revolutionary war veteran. Velda Routh wished to do so to qualify her daughter for DAR scholarships. We were unable to determine whether she was accepted as a member.

Velda Routh enlisted the assistance of a couple of family members, notably Dennis Carter, her nephew; and Jeanne Weaver, a cousin. She also hired Caren Prater, who worked at the Fleming County, Kentucky courthouse, to assist her with her research.

Scope and Content Note:

This collection includes genealogy research for Velda Budd Colwell Routh's family. These records include personal letters, photos, family group sheets, ancestor charts, newspaper articles (both originals and photocopies), photocopies of various historical records (including wills and court cases and birth, marriage, and death certificates), and handwritten notes.

Some of the main family names she traces back are the Budd, Vanlandingham, Routh, Blurton, Black, Naylor/Nailor, and Howell lines. Some names of notes are Phillip/Philip Howell and Edward Blurton, both of whom are said to have served in the Revolutionary War.

Velda created this collection between 1972 and 1999. However, the bulk of the correspondence and related documents come from 1989-1999. Velda kept carbon copies of many of her own typed letters. Some of the correspondence is undated—see, for example, "Folder 3: Correspondence - 'Ellen,' n.d."

The photocopied materials contain documents and information from the 1600s in England up to the 1990s.

Most of the documents concern family lineage in the Illinois, Indiana, and Kentucky areas.
