Historical Note:

Latino Voices of Champaign County was a project undertaken by the University of Illinois at Urbana Champaign Graduate School of Library and Information Science Community Archives course (LIS 590CA) during the 2012 spring semester. The project, undertaken with the Champaign County Historical Archives, gathered information concerning Latinos in Champaign County through interviews with individuals who directly serve the Latino community and who have witnessed its growth over the last twenty years. The class collected materials from various organizations throughout the county and compiled a resource guide. One of the major donors to the Latino Voices of Champaign County Project was the Latino Partnership.

The Latino Partnership of Champaign County evolved from an association of community partnerships in 2002 that sought to develop and improve services for the Latino community in Champaign County. They partner with over 40 public and non-profit organizations to eliminate discrimination, defend human and civil rights, support the development of individuals, and increase public awareness and understanding of issues pertaining to the Latino community. Scope and Content Note:

This collection contains materials about the Latino Voices of Champaign County Project and materials collected by the class during their research. Types of materials collected include business listings, immigration information, items from local events and places that are Latino centric, newspaper clippings, and a print out of the Latino Voices Project website.
