Biographical/Historical Note:

The Champaign-Urbana Welcome Club was established April 1943 as a club for women who were new to the Champaign-Urbana area. The group was sponsored in the beginning by the McKinley YMCA and the Champaign Chamber of Commerce. The group held teas, picnics, hosted speakers, and sponsored reading and sewing circles. Around 1950, the primary social activity of club switched to bridge.

Scope and Content Note:

This collection contains records pertaining to the operations of the Champaign-Urbana Welcome Club, including minutes, treasurer reports, president notebooks, scrapbooks, and directories. The records range in date from 1943-2012 with the bulk of the records pertaining to 1977-2009.
