- The service is available to residents within the Urbana city limits who live alone and have a physical condition that prevents their coming to the Library.
- There are no late fees on Urbana Free Library materials, but Home Delivery participants are responsible for lost and damaged materials or fees from other libraries.

- Deliveries are made every Wednesday morning between
 9:00 11:00 a.m. Adjustments are occasionally made for holidays, inclement weather, or volunteer scheduling.
